Continued to achieve carbon neutrality of the parcel delivery services in accordance with ISO 14068-1:2023

— Steadily implement plans to achieve carbon neutrality by FY2050 —

Yamato Transport (headquarters: Chuo-ku, Tokyo, Representative Director and President: Yutaka Nagao) has made a carbon neutrality claim*1 in accordance with the international standard ISO 14068-1:2023*2 for its TA-Q-BIN, TA-Q-BIN Compact, and EAZY (hereinafter "the parcel delivery services") continuing from FY2022 to FY2023. This claim was verified by BSI, a third-party organization, and on Tuesday, December 24, 2024, Yamato Transport received a certificate regarding the carbon neutrality*3 of the parcel delivery services in accordance with ISO 14068-1:2023. The certificate was awarded on Friday, January 31, 2025.

In addition, Yamato Transport supports "Deco-Katsu" *4, which is a new national movement promoted by the Ministry of the Environment to realize a decarbonized society. Through the carbon neutrality claim of the parcel delivery services, Yamato Transport contributes to support the new lifestyles of citizens and consumers.

1. Achievement of carbon neutrality in FY2023

Yamato Transport achieved carbon neutrality in accordance with ISO 14068-1:2023 by reducing GHG emissions through measures such as the introduction of EVs and solar power generation equipment, and offsetting all unabated emissions (2.33 million t-CO₂e*5) by retirement of carbon credits.

For the credits, 24 carbon credit projects related to renewable energy were selected. All of these credits are verified by third-party certification organizations.

(1) Subject of the claim (Products)

TA-Q-BIN (including Cool TA-Q-BIN), TA-Q-BIN Compact, EAZY

(2) Period

In accordance with ISO 14068-1:2023, Yamato Transport quantified the GHG missions and achieved carbon neutrality in FY2023.

Base year : April 1, 2021~March 31, 2022 (FY2021)

Achievement period : April 1, 2023~March 31, 2024 (FY2023)

Commitment period : FY2022~FY2050

2. Carbon neutrality management plan for the parcel delivery services by FY2050

To contribute to the sustainable future, Yamato Transport has announced to maintain carbon neutrality based on ISO 14068-1:2023 until FY2050 under BSI certification, by continuing efforts to reduce GHG emissions such as introduction of EVs and solar power generation equipment
