FPT Japan and Yamato Transport Sign Basic Agreement on Recruiting Vietnamese Drivers Under Japan's Specified Skilled Worker System

Greater transportation capacity for the entire logistics industry through a platform for recruiting and training non-Japanese drivers

FPT Japan Holdings Co., Ltd. (Head Office: Minato-ku, Tokyo; Representative Director and President: Do Van Khac), subsidiary of FPT Corporation (Headquarters: Socialist Republic of Vietnam; Founder and Chairman of the Board: Truong Gia Binh), and Yamato Transport Co., Ltd. (Headquarters: Chuo-ku, Tokyo; Representative Director and President: Seiichi Awa), subsidiary of Yamato Holdings Co., Ltd. (Head Office: Chuo-ku, Tokyo; Representative Director and President: Yutaka Nagao), have concluded a basic agreement as of Wednesday, November 12, 2025 to collaborate on hiring and training Vietnamese heavy-duty truck drivers utilizing Japan's specified skilled worker system to realize sustainable logistics in Japan.

The average age of heavy-duty truck drivers in Japan is 50.9 years old, 6.8 years older than the average of all industries*, making future-oriented truck driver cultivation an urgent issue in order to strengthen transportation capacity. At the same time, the number of people in Vietnam who wish to work abroad is increasing year by year, and the international mobility of talented young people is increasing.

By combining the human resource development expertise that the FPT Group has cultivated over many years in Vietnam with Yamato Transport's safety education, the two entities will build a foundation for training, establishing, and supporting the growth of non-Japanese

drivers. We will continue to create new value through cross-border collaboration to realize a sustainable future.

■ Overview of the Recruitment and Training Platform for Heavy-duty Truck Drivers at Yamato Transport

Special classes will be offered at educational institutions in Vietnam operated by the FPT Group to provide comprehensive support for the recruitment and training of heavy-duty truck drivers who will handle middle-mile transportation between locations for Yamato Transport in Japan. After joining Yamato Transport, the company will provide an environment in which non-Japanese specified skilled workers can live and work in Japan with peace of mind, as well as support their growth as heavy-duty truck drivers. The targeted new headcount is 100 per year.

- 1. Soliciting Applicants for Enrollment in Vietnam
- Establishing new special classes at FPT Group's educational institution
- Accepting applications for prospective students from December 2025

- 2. Training in Vietnam (Six Months)
- Launching special classes in 2026
- Participants study Japanese language (N4 level), Japanese culture (basic), and Yamato Transport-supervised safety (basic)
- Participants take the motor vehicle transportation specified skills evaluation test); test may be taken after studying in Japan
- 3. Training in Japan (One Year)
- Participants enroll in FPT Japan's Japanese language school as an overseas exchange student in 2026
- Participants study Japanese language (N3 level), Japanese culture (applied), and Yamato Transport-supervised safety (applied)
- Participants take the test to convert a foreign driver's license to a Japanese driver's license
- Participants obtain a large motor vehicle Class I driver's license
- 4. Start of Work in Japan as a Non-Japanese Specified Skilled Worker (Five Years)
- Participants join Yamato Transport as employees in 2027
- After obtaining Yamato Transport's in-house driver's license, employees work as heavy-duty truck drivers responsible for middle-mile transportation
- Yamato Transport provides a safe working environment by supporting employees' daily life and improving their driving skills, etc.
