Selected for the Second Consecutive Year as a CDP Climate Change A-List Company, Earning its Highest Rating

In the CDP questionnaire regarding action against climate change, Yamato Holdings Co., Ltd. (Head Office: Chuo-ku, Tokyo; Representative Director and President: Yutaka Nagao) has been selected for the second consecutive year as an A-List company, the highest rating given to only the top few percent of responding companies. This is recognition of the Yamato Group's leadership in transparency and performance as one of the world's leading companies in addressing climate change.

Environmental information disclosure and its evaluation under the framework established by CDP, a non-profit organization that conducts international environmental research and disclosure, is widely recognized as a global standard. In 2025, more than 22,100 companies worldwide made environmental disclosures through the CDP and were rated on an eight-tier scale, from A to D-.



The Yamato Group recognizes that mitigating climate change is an important management issue,

and is moving forward with various initiatives in this area, mainly through measures such as introducing EVs and solar power generation facilities toward virtually zero in-house greenhouse gas emissions by 2050 and a 48% reduction in greenhouse gas emissions by 2030 (versus fiscal year 2020).

In addition, we are working to create new business models to solve environmental and social issues, such as carbon neutral delivery for TA-Q-BIN parcels, which is an initiative to mitigate climate change throughout society, as well as the establishment of Yamato Energy Management Corporation to provide renewable energy power and other services by utilizing the knowledge and expertise accumulated within the Yamato Group, and furthermore the launch of the GHG Reporting Service to track GHG emissions generated in the transportation and delivery processes for products such as TA-Q-BIN.

Going forward, the Yamato Group will continue efforts to mitigate climate change and help bring about a sustainable future in which society and business can develop together.

What is the CDP?

The CDP, formerly known as the Carbon Disclosure Project, is a non-governmental organization (NGO) established in 2000 and managed by a British charity. CDP analyzes and evaluates the environmental activities of companies around the world based on their disclosed information and assigns a score from A (highest) to D-. Environmental disclosure and evaluations under the CDP framework are widely recognized as a global standard for corporate environmental disclosure. In 2025, more than 640 signatory financial institutions with assets of more than US\$127 trillion are required to disclose data on their environmental impacts, risks, and opportunities through the CDP platform.
