## Yamato Holdings Selected for the First Time as Sustainability Yearbook Member in S&P Global's Sustainability Assessment

Yamato Holdings Co., Ltd. (Head Office: Chuo-ku, Tokyo; Representative Director and President: Yutaka Nagao) hereby announces that it has been selected for the first time as a member of The Sustainability Yearbook 2026, a set of rankings by global ESG investment research and evaluation firm S&P Global based on an assessment of companies with outstanding sustainability performance. This selection is in recognition of specific achievements by the Yamato Group in the areas of governance, economy, environment, and society, as well as its commitment to transparently disclosing processes for these respective areas.

For 2026, more than 9,200 leading companies from 59 industries around the world were evaluated, and 848 were selected as members of the Sustainability Yearbook. Among Japanese companies, 69 were selected, including two in Yamato Holdings' industry of Transportation and Transportation Infrastructure.



With its vision for 2030 to "be a value-creating company that contributes to the realization of a sustainable future" and based on its Medium-Term Management Plan "Sustainability Transformation 2030 ~1st Stage~ ("SX2030 1st Stage"), the Yamato Group is engaged in management aimed at enhancing the sustainability of both society and companies by combining economic, environmental, and social value. In particular, the Group is focused on promoting green logistics to mitigate climate change and solving social issues through co-creation with diverse partners, and is disclosing these efforts to stakeholders.

Going forward, the Group will continue to promote sustainability initiatives to realize a sustainable future in which society and the Group develop alongside one another, and will strive to enhance its corporate value by providing highly transparent disclosure to diverse stakeholders.
