Integrated Business Solutions Base in Konan City, Shiga Prefecture to Commence Full-Scale Operations from June 2026 Providing logistics solutions by taking advantage of its highly accessible location to the Keihanshin area, the largest consumption area in the Kansai region

Yamato Transport Co., Ltd. (Headquarters: Chuo-ku, Tokyo; Representative Director and President: Seiichi Awa; hereinafter "Yamato Transport") announces that it will commence full-scale operations of its newly established integrated business solutions base (hereinafter "the Base") in Konan City, Shiga Prefecture.

Starting Monday, June 1, 2026, the Base will newly operate sorting, transportation, and delivery functions for the Yamato Group's logistics bases nationwide. By integrating with the logistics functions that have been operating since October 2025, Yamato Transport aims to contribute to optimizing the entire supply chain of its customers and expand its corporate business.



■ Features of the Base

This facility provides logistics solutions that integrate the Yamato Group's logistics functions with sorting and distribution operations bound for logistics hubs nationwide.

Shiga Prefecture is a region where the manufacturing industry is actively expanding, backed by geographical advantages such as the abundant water resources of Lake Biwa. By consolidating suppliers' logistics using the Base, Yamato Transport will support the efficiency of the manufacturing industry's supply chain.

1. Providing High Value-added Logistics Services

By performing logistics operations—such as inventory management and value-added processing—as well as sorting and distribution to destinations nationwide all within a single facility, we are able to extend the order cutoff time for next-day delivery and reduce lead times for product delivery. This helps our corporate customers maximize their sales opportunities.

In addition, by eliminating the need for transportation and transshipment between warehouses and distribution centers, this initiative will help improve transport quality and reduce greenhouse gas emissions.

Additionally, the presence of inventory locations on the Yamato Group's transportation and delivery network allows for speedy replenishment and movement of inventory between locations in response to demand, contributing to inventory optimization.

2. Highly Accessible Location to Keihanshin, the Largest Consumption Area in the Kansai Region, and Capable of BCP Support

Located approximately 2.1 km from the Ritto-Konan Interchange on the Meishin Expressway and within a 100 km radius of Kyoto City in Kyoto Prefecture, Osaka Prefecture, and Kobe City in Hyogo Prefecture, which are major cities in the Kansai region, the Base is an excellent location as a wide-area logistics hub for the Kansai region. In addition, because it is accessible to two expressways, the Meishin Expressway and the Shin-Meishin Expressway, business activities can be continued by securing detour routes in the event of a disaster.

By having customers with major bases in eastern Japan store inventory at the Base, Yamato Transport supports the BCP of corporate customers, such as mitigating inventory supply risks in the event of a disaster.
